**Registration availability dates will be posted online before each session. Our lessons are divided into 3 age brackets.**

- *Pre-School classes ages 3-5*
- *Children - Ages 6 & Older*
- *Mom & Me - 6 months to 2 years*

The Mom & Me class promotes water adaptation and water safety. The parent will learn the skills necessary to teach the child how to be safe through basic swimming skills with toys and games. Swim Diapers are required for children that are not yet potty trained.

## SWIM SCHOOL POLICIES

We ask that parents leave the deck area during swim class. We find that children are far more attentive and susceptible to learning the new skills if parents are "out of sight, out of mind." There is spectator seating located upstairs if you wish to observe the classes. Other children must not be in the deck area and must be supervised at all times.

No make up classes are offered. Space is held with payment only. Concurrent enrollment is not insured without payment and registration is based on space availability only. We reserve the right to cancel or consolidate classes when minimum enrollment numbers are not achieved.

Refunds are only afforded when we cancel and the student cannot be rescheduled to a time that is convenient. We offer credit letters which may be applied to future sessions in cases of extended illness or injury.
